



FROM THE SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT & GENERAL MANAGER

It is with great pride that I present you with the Los Angeles Convention Center's fourth Annual Report. As I reflect on the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year (FY), I am reminded of how far we have come since AEG Facilities took over management in 2013. We have established and met or exceeded countless goals through hard work and strategic planning. This past year, we focused on sustainability and safety when launching building improvement projects while upholding significant revenues, event attendance and corporate responsibility projects.

The LACC ended this fiscal year with an impressive operating surplus of \$10.1 million, before reimbursing the City of Los Angeles \$5.2 million for the Department of Convention & Tourism Development (CTD) expenses, Staples Bond payment, an allocation for other City services, and Utility user taxes. The LACC added another \$1 million to the reserve, accumulating \$8.1 million at the conclusion of FY 2017-2018 and surpassing the initial management goal of building a financial reserve of \$2.1 million in five years.

\$3.9 million of the surplus was invested into the completion of 50 Alteration & Improvement (A&I) projects and Capital Improvement Projects (CIP). Many of these projects reflected our priority of safety and sustainability. Our safety was greatly enhanced through the addition of K12-rated, truck-resistant security bollards to protect the South & West Hall exterior entry points. We continued to push the envelope by adding new sustainability measures including the new 9.500 sq. ft. rooftop garden, lighting retrofit with 2.146 LED lamps across all exhibit halls and 2.21 megawatt solar array on the roof of South Hall. These projects will lessen the environmental impact that the LACC has on Los Angeles as well as improve operational efficiency.

Our sustainability initiatives were widely recognized when we received the Governor's Environmental and Economic Leadership Award (GEELA) and Los Angeles County Green Leadership Award. The LACC was honored by Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr. for our ongoing and robust sustainability program and exemplary achievements in conserving and protecting natural resources. AEG Facilities' "Next Level Sustainability" campaign at the LACC was recognized in Los Angeles County for reducing

the LACC's carbon footprint and expanding the LACC's sustainable practices across five areas – waste/recycling, energy/climate, water, purchasing and education/communication.

This annual report is a testament to our continual commitment to excellence. Our talented and hardworking staff at the LACC has made FY 2017-2018 another successful year in partnership with the CTD, LATCB and AEG Corporate. Please enjoy the highlights of the following pages. Thank you for your continued support and interest in the LACC. We look forward to sharing more milestones in the years ahead.








OPERATING SURPLUS DISTRIBUTION






REVENUES BY CATEGORY






REVENUES BY EVENT TYPE








\$8.1 Million in the Reserve

In keeping with convention center management best practices, AEG Facilities set out to build a financial reserve of \$2.1 million within the 5 years of its initial management agreement.

This goal has been surpassed well before the 5-year mark adding \$1 million to the reserve this year. At the conclusion of this fiscal year, the LACC reserve has reached \$8.1 million.




PROFIT ALLOCATION SINCE PRIVATE MANAGEMENT

FACILITIES & OPERATIONS

Operational efficiencies completed in the past fiscal year include both facility upgrades and preventative maintenance while reducing the venue's environmental footprint. For instance, the LED lighting retrofit project replaced 2,146 LED lamps in all exhibit halls. The completion of this project estimates over one million kilowatt hours saved annually.

LACC spent \$3.9 million on 50 Alteration & Improvement Projects funded by the operating surplus. In addition, AEG managed CIP Projects funded by the City.



AEG MANAGED PROJECTS

 - Upgraded Galaxy Cafe upholstery and added new furniture
 - Completed West Hall roof repairs
 - Replaced and upgraded Food & Beverage (F&B) equipment including coffee brewers
 - Completed ADA restriping of South & West Hall parking garages
 - Replaced two trash compactors
 - Completed South Hall floor remediation
 - Upgraded three marquees to programmable signs
 - Added catering tables
 - Completed ADA accessible walkway

The new 2.21 megawatt solar array was unveiled on April 4, 2018 during a press conference with Mayor Eric Garcetti. Located on the roof of South Hall, this addition brings LACC's total solar capacity to 2.58 megawatts, making it the largest solar array on a municipally owned convention center in the United States.

> The new array includes 6,228 panels at 355 watts each. It is projected to generate 3.4 million kilowatt hours per year that equates to 17 percent of the LACC's annual energy usage. This amount of electricity produced can power 565 homes in Los Angeles.

> > The project reduces the LACC's carbon footprint by 2,554 metric tons per year, which is the equivalent to removing 2,794,396 pounds of coal from being burned or planting 66,192 trees.

SECURITY DEPARTMENT & GUEST SERVICES

SECURITY ENHANCEMENTS & ACCOMPLISHMENTS INCLUDE:

- Installed K12-rated, truck-resistant security bollards to South and West Hall exterior entry points
- Strategically placed 18 CCTV cameras to capture Food & Beverage point of sales, warehouses, food courts and main kitchens to ensure safety, security and liabilities of the LACC
- Added 5 CCTV cameras with infrared lenses on the loading docks that allow greater visibility at night
- Added 636 door contacts throughout perimeter of the facility with alarms that ties into access control systems and alerts our command center
- All 7 catwalk entry points added access control and were re-keyed, door contacts were added to all upper roof hatches and 5 cameras were placed to monitor the catwalks
- Added a full-time manager to the team to assist with administration and special projects

• Conducted 2 separate active shooter trainings with LAPD where employees were provided with classroom learning and live scenario training to have a stronger understanding of the Run, Hide, Fight program

GUEST SERVICES HIGHLIGHTS INCLUDE:

- Guest Services Department has grown to include a manager, two part-time supervisors and ten part-time representatives
- The Guest Services Manager was certified in First Aid, CPR and AED usage and used this experience to lead the training of both LACC and CTD staff
- The Guest Services team formed a close relationship with the Facilities Department to collect, organize and donate unclaimed items from events
- Together the Guest Services and Facilities Departments donated 592 pounds of items to the Salvation Army

The in-house Security and Guest Services Department at the Los Angeles Convention Center focuses on keeping our facility, guests and employees safe. These departments have improved client and attendee safety and experience with top of the line strategies and best practices.



MARKETING & SOCIAL MEDIA ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The LACC regularly collaborates with clients to assist with social media co-promotion, which generates positive exposure for both the event and the facility. The LACC primarily utilizes Facebook, Twitter and Instagram.
