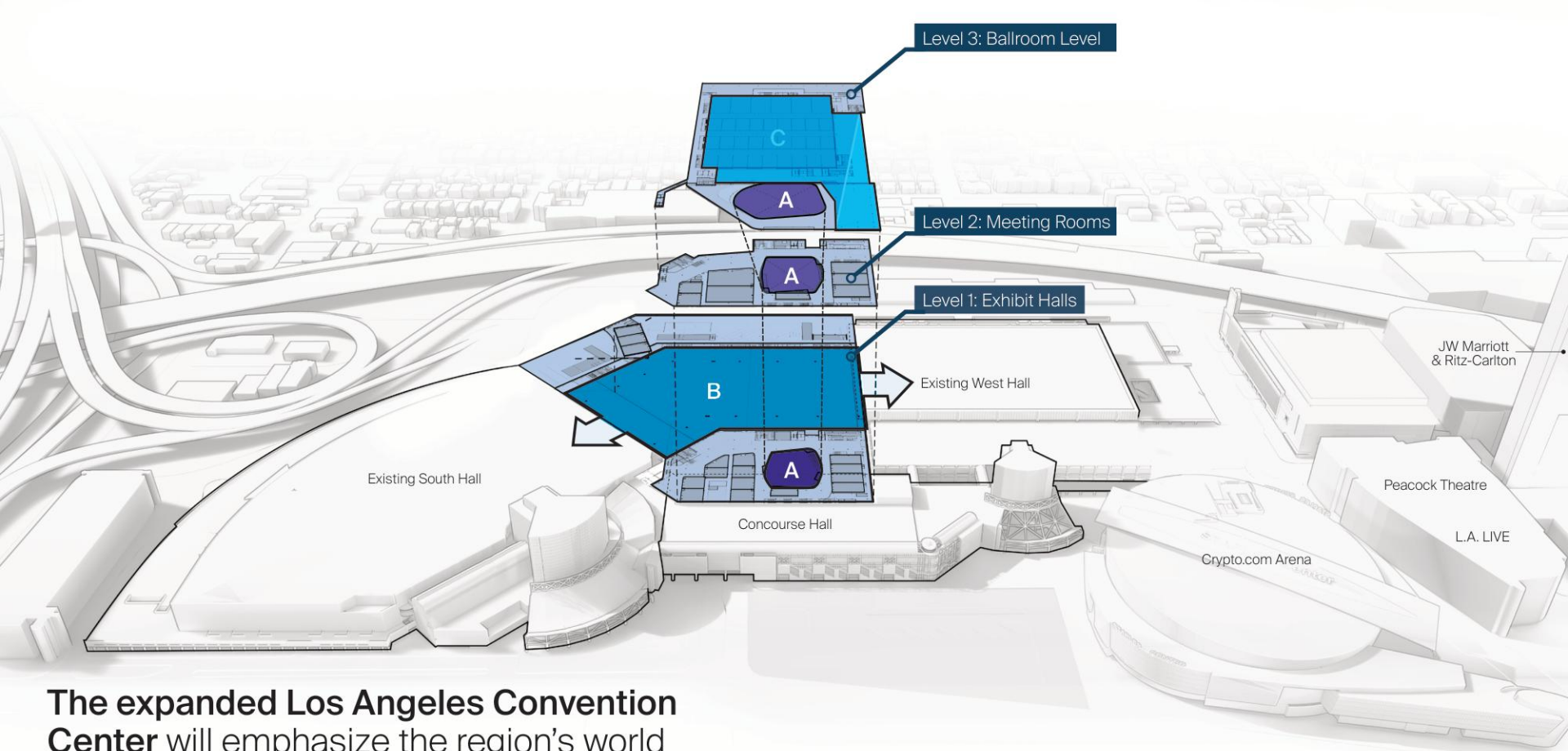

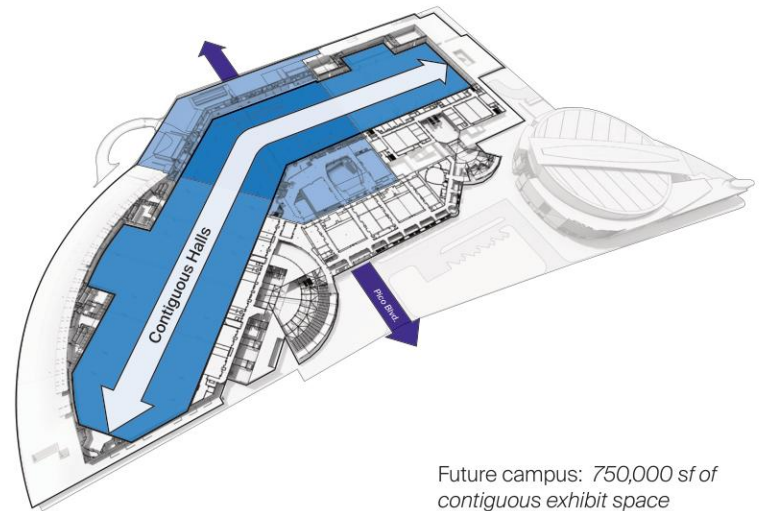
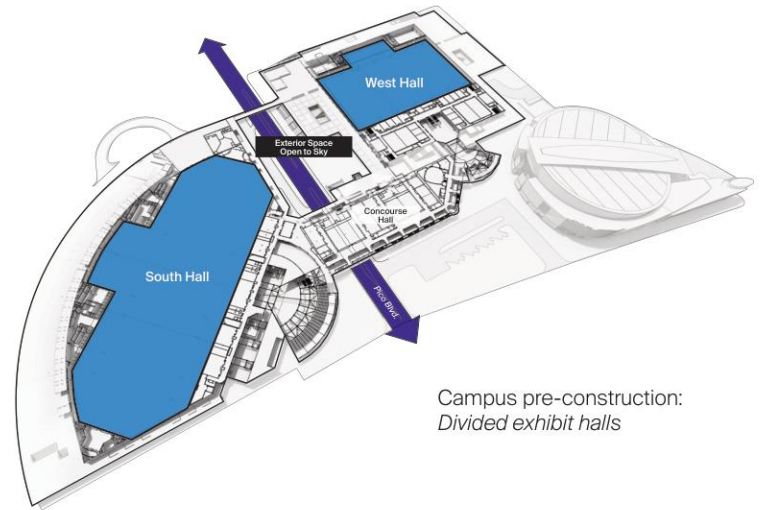
New connections Historically, the Los Angeles Convention Center exhibit halls were bisected by Pico Boulevard—with South Hall and West Hall bridged by Concourse Hall. Beginning in early 2029, organizers and planners will be able to hold large-scale events in one contiguous hall.

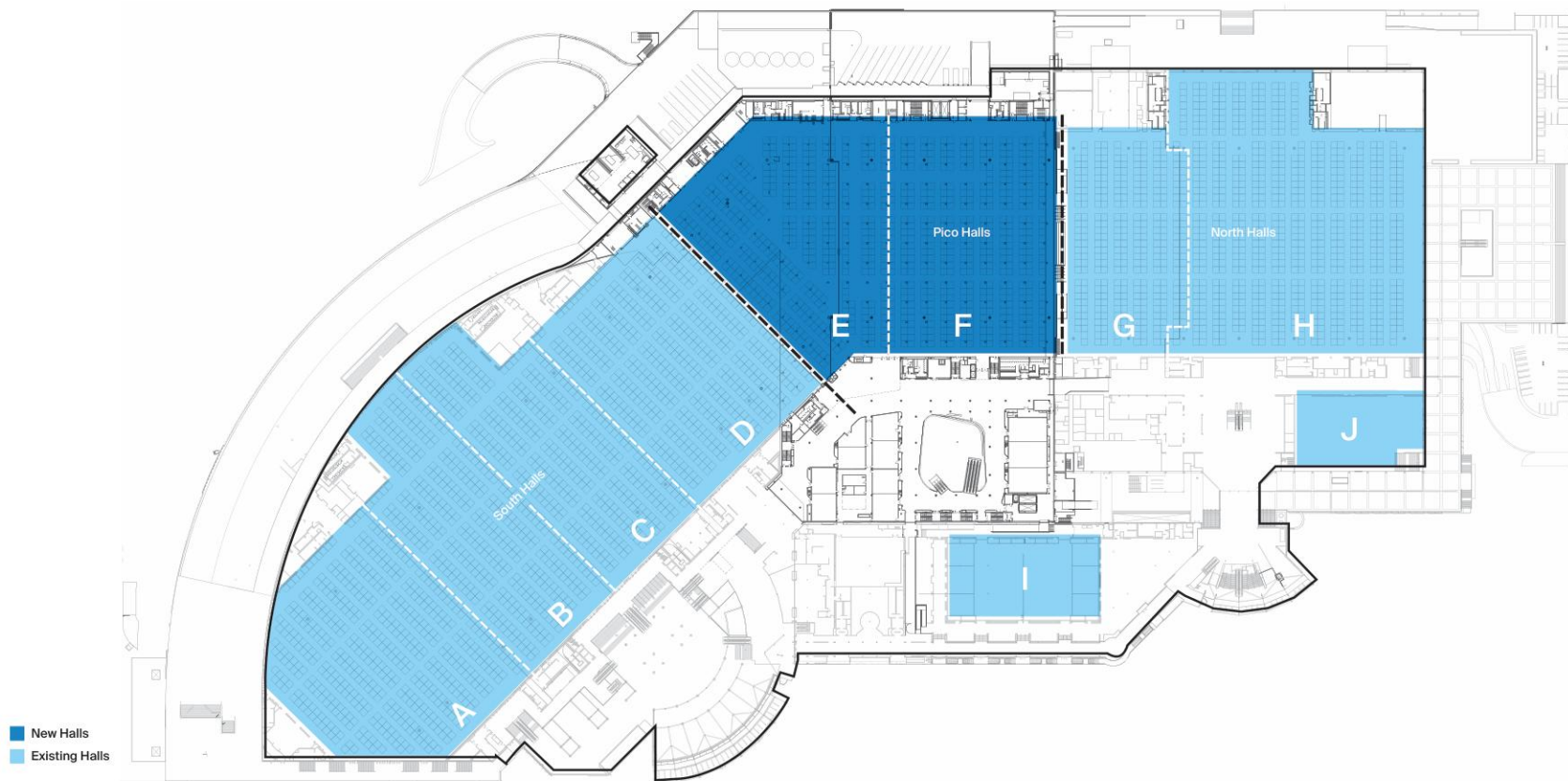
Contiguous with a purpose The Center's Expansion and Modernization Project will deliver 750,000 square feet of contiguous exhibit space. Above Pico Boulevard, the newly added 193,000-square-foot space will connect South Hall and West Hall. Also on offer: Lobby-level access to Skynode and a new suite of carpeted and column-free meeting rooms.

Flexibility Airwalls will allow the space to be divided into seven smaller halls as needed. Please reference plans for exhibit hall divisibility.

- Electrical: Floor boxes 30' o.c. in both directions
- Rigging: 15' o.c. in both directions
- Lighting: Dimmable LED high wattage/high bay
- Acoustic Performance: NIC 50, STC 60, NC 25
- Display: Infrastructure to support fully portable systems
- Video: IP-based distribution, IPTV
- Audio: IP-based, dedicated, specialized
- Video teleconferencing and room monitoring support
- Assisted listening supported

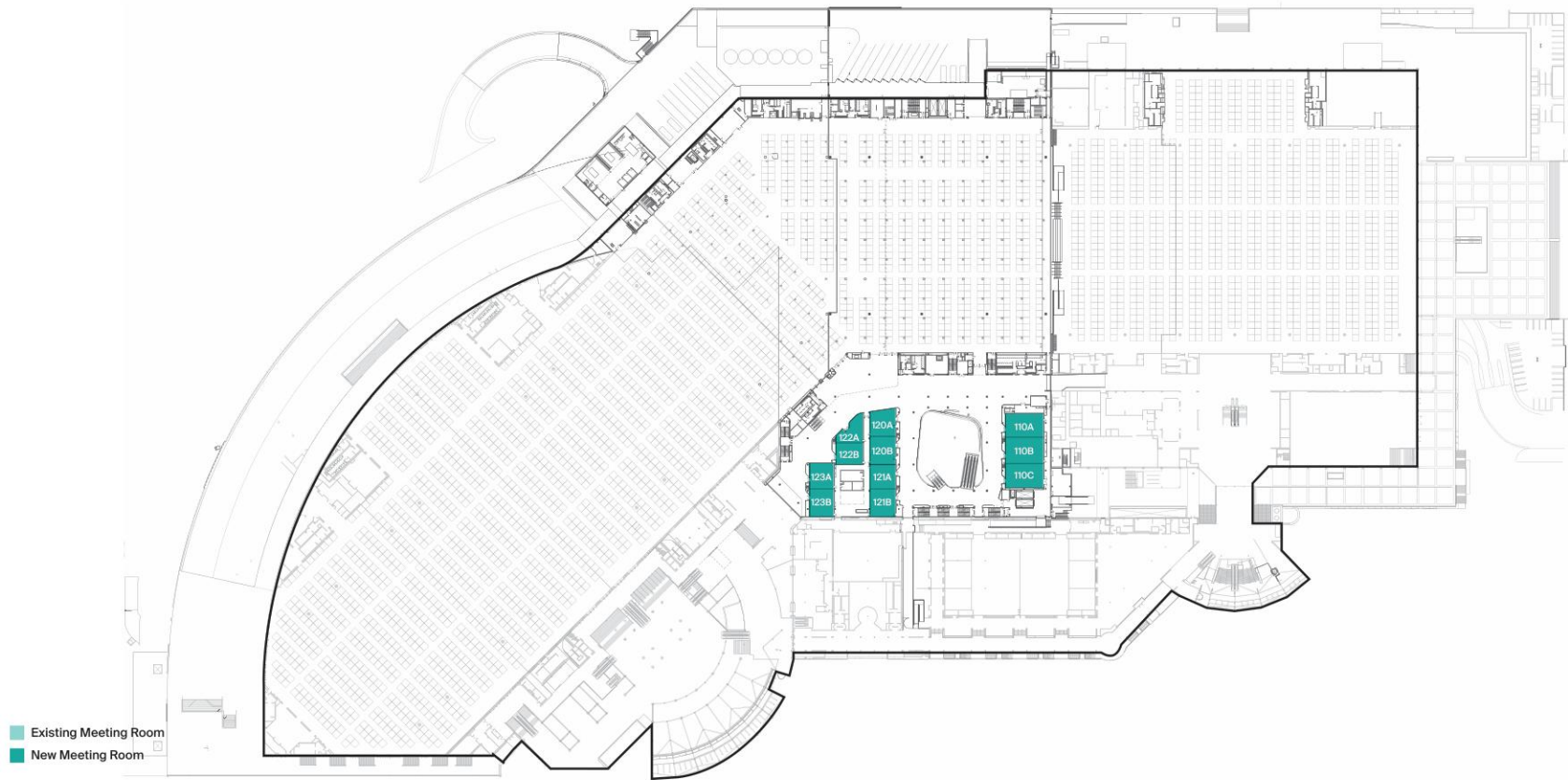

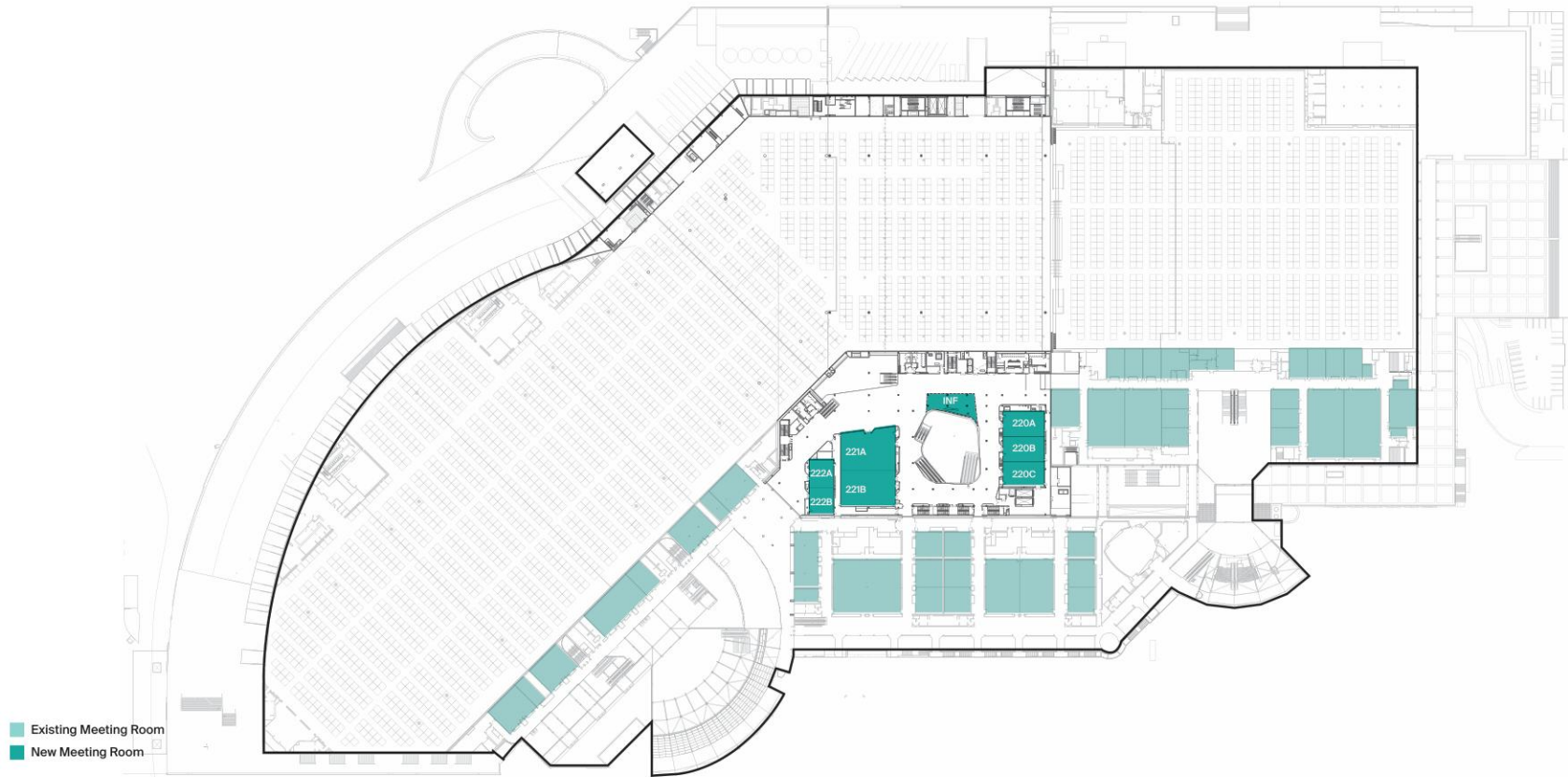

The 98,000-square-foot ballroom will provide event organizers with the ultimate in flexibility. Whether planning an event for 12 – or up to 9,700 – airwalls will allow the space to be divided into numerous acoustically-separated configurations.

Pre-function with a view

Indoors and out will seamlessly become one for guests arriving via the Skynode escalator. The new pre-function space – surrounded by glass walls revealing world-famous views – leads to our ballroom for unparalleled dining and entertainment experiences, as well as to the roof terrace for al fresco moments found nowhere else.

Up on the roof

A destination in and of itself, guests arriving onto the roof terrace will experience a breathtaking view of the City of Angels – from Downtown to the Hollywood Hills. An open-air reprieve beneath a swooping roof canopy, the location also functions as an event space. Seating areas tucked into the landscaping will allow for private moments of escape, fresh air, and meaningful connections with a world-class metropolis.

The carpeted and column-free 98,000-square-foot ballroom – perfect for large general sessions – can also be transformed into eleven smaller meeting rooms that are ideal for educational presentations and networking, thanks to the use of optimally placed airwalls.

Pre-function space will harness both the north and east ends of the ballroom, allowing multiple sessions and events to take place simultaneously.

Loading in and out will be a breeze thanks to direct access to freight elevators that connect to a new loading dock.

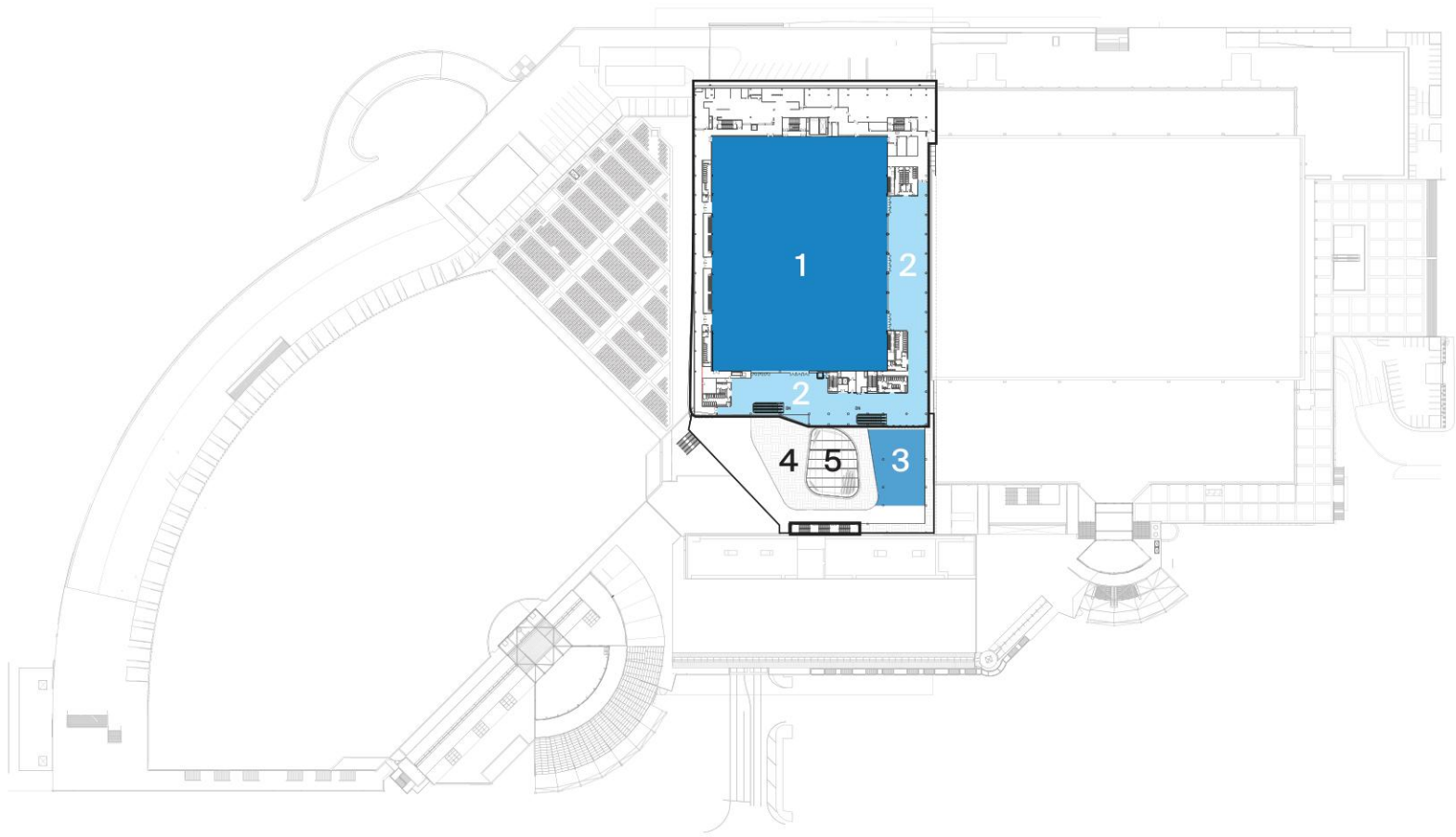

Resources / FAQs

When will the Center's expansion be completed?

The majority of construction will be complete by Spring 2028. Construction will be paused for the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games at the LACC between June and October 2028 to allow for the Games to occur. After the 2028 Games, construction will resume and the project will be complete by Spring 2029.

Will existing events be affected during construction?

The Los Angeles Convention Center will remain fully operational throughout the expansion project. Construction activities will be concentrated primarily behind and between the existing facility, minimizing disruption to ongoing events. The Convention Center team is committed to collaborating closely with clients and partners to mitigate potential impacts and ensure the highest level of service during this period.

Will your new roof terrace be available for events?

Yes, the roof terrace will be available for events, providing an iconic setting with panoramic views of the Downtown Los Angeles skyline and the Hollywood Hills which will elevate any occasion.
